

Raising Dust & Dollars - 2006 19th Annual Great Endeavour Rally

Ian Doyle, Bob Grant and Norm Haupt are three ordinary blokes preparing to embark upon an extraordinary adventure - the 2006 19th Annual Great Endeavour Rally.

The Great Endeavour Rally is Australia's largest off-road event, and an important fundraising event for Endeavour. Last year the event began in Kingaroy, Queensland and travelled to Coffs Harbour, New South Wales via Tasmania. This year, the rally goes from Rockhampton to Coolangatta, via Kurumba.

"We found out about the Endeavour Rally at the Brisbane car show a few years back," explains Ian. "We thought it looked like fun. Within two weeks we had a car and a team, and we haven't looked back since." Ian, Bob and Norm - or 'The Vision Alert Team' - will be entering the event for the fourth time in July this year, and the boys agree it's just like a family reunion.

"We love catching up with all the regulars. We have heaps of fun, playing practical jokes on each other (the old 'vegemite-under-the-

door-handle' trick is a favourite), and there's a really friendly and welcoming environment," Ian said. "It's a well-organised event, doesn't cost a lot to participate, and newcomers are treated well. I'd recommend it to anybody."

"This is the kind of event where it doesn't matter if you come first or last," adds Bob. "But there's a real determination to complete the trip - people have been known to hire tow trucks to get their burnt out cars across the finish line. It goes to show the spirit of the event."

The Vision Alert Team has also developed a strong bond with several of the Endeavour clients who participate in the rally from year to year. "It's great having them on the road with us," says Ian. "It really wouldn't be the same without them. They remind us of what we're really here for - the money we raise goes to a really great cause."

PricewaterhouseCoopers Foundation come to the rescue

In an example of true Australian spirit, PricewaterhouseCoopers staff came to Endeavour's rescue immediately after Cyclone Larry hit the Innisfail area. Their concern and generosity provided Endeavour with generators and much needed funds. The \$90,000 PricewaterhouseCoopers and their staff raised will help to ease the nightmare and go towards re-establishing the staff and clients' lives.

"As soon as we heard that Cyclone Larry had devastated the Innisfail community, we thought of the Endeavour clients, and their staff who provide them with crucial support," said PricewaterhouseCoopers National Coordinator, Carolyn Bruce. "We gave Endeavour a call to find out what support they needed. The first things they needed were generators, followed by funds to help with the rebuilding process. We were overwhelmed by the generosity of our people who, in just over a week, contributed over \$46,000, which was then dollar-for-dollar matched by the firm."

Approximately 40 Endeavour clients/supported employees and 18 staff were affected by the cyclone in some way. Many staff and clients

suffered severe damage to their homes, and some staff have partners who lost their jobs when surrounding farms were flattened. "Endeavour's property loss in the overall scheme of things was relatively small," explained Area Manager Disability Services Margaret Dalton. "But the personal trauma and property loss experienced by clients and staff cannot be underestimated. Therefore, Endeavour is particularly grateful for the prompt reaction from the PricewaterhouseCoopers Foundation. The generous donation has enabled staff and clients to start thinking about rebuilding their homes and their lives. Without their help, the staff and clients might still be wondering what to do, or who to turn to."

"We know the Endeavour staff have worked long, hard hours, even to the point of putting their own personal lives aside for the benefit of their clients," said Ms Bruce. "They are heroes who deserve all the help they can get and we are extremely proud to have been able to support them."
